To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting: Homestead Certificate No. 332 THIRETENS There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the Register APPLICATION 707 of the LAND OFFICE at Theron Arigona Verritory , whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the Lot numbered him of Section twelve in Township six South of Range twenty four bast and the Loto numbered three, five and six and the North bast quarter of the South West greater of Section seven in Township Rix South of Range twenty five bast of Isla and Salt River Melidian in Arigona Territory, containing one hundred and fifty two acres and sixty nine. hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General; How know ue, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Cobeneger Bryce the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said & beneger Bryce heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.
